one thing, experts say men can focus better when there are no members of the opposite sex present. It allows them more freedom to be themselves without fear of embarrassment. This results in them opening up more and sharing their problems without reservation.

Why do men talk less when women are around? Experts believe it's because of societal expectations. In other words, men feel an awkwardness when in a group setting to discuss their problems. On a subconscious level, they feel like they should be "strong" and in their mind, sharing problems makes them feel weak when women are present.

In addition, another benefit of a male-only rehab program is that it helps eliminate the chance of romantic relationships developing during therapy. By separating men and women into their own treatment programs, you remove the element of attraction. This allows men to focus entirely on the rehab experience and the healing journey.
